

Michigan's Energy Protections and Assistance During COVID-19 Pandemic

The State of Michigan and local energy companies are working to ensure protections are in place for customers as efforts to help slow the spread of the coronavirus impact families and businesses across the state.

FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS

Be proactive in contacting your utility company as soon as you know you will be unable to pay your bill on time. See contact information below.

Call 2-1-1 or visit <u>mi211.org</u> for critical needs such as food, child care and more. Trained operators will connect you to assistance for a range of needs.

FOR LOW INCOME HOUSEHOLDS

See if you qualify for State Emergency Relief (SER) to help pay part of your energy bill, assist in keeping energy services, or help restore service. Call your local <u>Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) office</u> for information or apply on <u>MI Bridges</u>. Search for a <u>MDHHS community partner</u> that can help you navigate the application process. Households must apply for SER assistance prior to receiving any Michigan Energy Assistance Program (MEAP) services.

In response to COVID-19, DHHS made the following changes to SER policy in order to allow for faster processing of emergency requests and to make access to benefits easier for Michigan's most vulnerable households.

- · Elimination of phone interviews reduces the amount of time a customer spends getting assistance
- Suspension of one-time energy payments allows customers that received one SER payment and haven't reached the cap to apply for another SER
- Elimination of the shortfall determination eliminates SER co-payments for most customers
- Increase in non-cash asset test to \$15,000 allows more people in crisis to qualify for SER

Choose a <u>MEAP provider</u> to work with at the time of SER application. MEAP works with households to provide supplemental bill payment assistance and self-sufficiency services to low-income residents statewide.

Apply for a Home Heating Credit to help pay winter heating bills if you are low-income or receive public assistance. Eligible customers must meet guidelines based on 2019 household income, exemptions and heating costs, and must apply by Sept. 30 each year. The application form (MI-1040CR-7) can be requested from the Michigan Department of Treasury at 517-636-4486 or by visiting the <u>website</u>.

FOR SMALL BUSINESS CUSTOMERS AND NON-PROFITS

Be proactive in contacting your utility company as soon as you know you will be unable to pay your bill on time. Utility companies may be able to offer flexible payment terms or suggestions to manage utility bills under these extraordinary circumstances. See contact information below.
